<i>Grade level</i>	9 <sup>th</sup> grade English Class
<i>Time duration</i>	55 minutes
<i>Objective</i>	Encourage students think critically about the aftermath of the Holocaust and its survivors, the differences between narratives in a book setting and an oral history, and the results of those narratives in the remembrance of the Holocaust
