- Coordinated by Jews in the ghetto with help from Poles
- Effort to halt the deportation of Jews to killing centers
- Nearly a thousand resistance fighters
- Nazis razed the ghetto with artillery and aircraft
- Inspired several other revolts in camps and ghettos

Victim Testimony

- Emanuel Ringelblum, Warsaw
- Member of Jewish organizations within the ghettos
- Collected the testimonies of hundreds of Jewish refugees, with the intention of recovering after the war
